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Three hacked to death in gang rivalry in Puducherry

THREE people, including the son of a murdered notorious rowdy, were hacked to death in Puducherry. A special police team arrested four suspects and is conducting further investigations.

According to the police, they received information on Wednesday morning that three individuals were found with severe injuries behind an abandoned house on 7th Cross Street in Rainbow Nagar. Police teams from Muthialpet and Grand Bazaar police stations rushed to the spot and found two of them dead with deep cuts on their heads and faces. Another person, who was critically injured, was taken to the Puducherry Government General Hospital in an auto-rickshaw but succumbed to his injuries shortly after admission.

Following this, senior officials, including DIG Sathiyar Sundaram, Senior SP Narra Chaitanya, and East Senior police officials, arrived at the scene with over 30 police personnel. A forensic team and a sniffer dog named Roger were

also deployed to collect evidence. The deceased were identified as D Rishid (25) from Oulgaret, son of Desthan, a rowdy who was murdered in 2008, and S Panneer Deva (25) from Thidir Nagar. The injured person, Adhi (24) from JJ Nagar, died at the hospital. Upon hearing about the incident, the victims' relatives rushed to the crime scene.

Based on a complaint from Rishid's relatives, the Grand Bazaar police registered a murder case. "Three special teams have been formed to track down the culprits," a senior police

source said. The police have also collected CCTV footage from the area as part of their investigation.

Sources said the victims were murdered for allegedly monitoring the movements of a rival gang. "Four suspects have been detained, and efforts are on to arrest the prime suspect and his associates," a source added. The incident, particularly the murder of the son of a known rowdy, has raised tensions in Puducherry. The deceased's father was also allegedly murdered over a gang rivalry a few years back.

Crowd blocks road after sexual assault of girl; teacher held

A large group of people staged a road blockade near Thavalakuppam on the Puducherry-Cuddalore road on Friday evening, demanding strict action against a private school teacher accused of sexually assaulting a six-and-a-half-year-old girl studying in Class 2. According to police, the child's parents noticed her reluctance to go to school for the past few days and questioned her. She then revealed a teacher at her school, had sexually assaulted her. Following this, the family, along with relatives and villagers, gathered and surrounded the school.

Upon receiving information, the police arrived at the scene and attempted to detain the teacher. However, villagers and relatives attacked him and vandalised the school office. The police forcibly dispersed the crowd and took the teacher into custody and an investigation is under way.

More than a hundred villagers and the child's relatives blocked the Puducherry-Cuddalore road at the Thavalakuppam junction from Friday evening, condemning the police and demanding strict action against the teacher. The protest,

which lasted for over four hours, disrupted traffic movement.

Puducherry Assembly Speaker R Selvam, Collector A Kulothungan, and senior police officials held discussions with the protesters. During the talks, the collector assured that the school would be sealed. Later, in an order issued at night, he informed that the public exams scheduled at the school on Saturday were postponed.

Teacher assaults 15-year-old, held under PocsO Act

A teacher (42) of a government higher secondary school in Krishnagiri has been arrested for allegedly sexually assaulting a 15-year-old, class 10 boy. The school education department has placed the teacher under suspension. Police said on February 1, the boy attended a wedding in the family of another teacher. There, this teacher took him to the rest room for the marriage hall and sexually assaulted him.

On Friday, the boy's parents secured the teacher and handed him to Krishnagiri All Women Police. A case was registered under the PocsO Act and he was arrested. Police added that the boy reported the incident to the school headmaster and sought action but he told him to stay quiet.

CEO (in-charge) A Muniraj said investigation is being conducted by the District Child Protection Unit and school education department.

Steps on to give honorarium to more women: Deputy CM

ADDRESSING a mass wedding ceremony, organised by the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowment Department, Deputy Chief Minister Udayanidhi Stalin revealed that steps are being taken by the state government to increase the number of beneficiaries under the Kalaigal Magalir Urimai Thogai (KMUT) scheme.

"Following the directives of the Chief Minister M K Stalin, steps are being taken to extend the benefits to even more wom-

en in the coming months," he said, adding that more than 1.15 crore women have already benefited under the scheme.

The HR&CE department organised the marriage ceremony for 30 couples in the city. During his address, Udayanidhi said that the previous AI-ADMK government put a hold on the state-sponsored wedding scheme. However, under the present government led by CM Stalin, the initiative was revived in 2022 by HR&CE Minister P K Sekarbabu. "Since then, nearly 1,800 weddings have been conducted under this scheme," he noted.

Parents seek probe into girl's death at hostel

PARENTS of a six-year-old autistic girl, who was studying at a special school in Palayamkottai, have petitioned the city police on Friday alleging that their daughter died under mysterious circumstances at the hostel.

Sources said, the deceased girl, identified as Abitha, was the second child of Madasamy and Jaya from Thoothukudi. "On Thursday night, the school authorities informed Jaya that her daughter fell in the bathroom and was being taken to a nearby hospital. She was then referred to the Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital (TVMCH). When Jaya reached the hospital, doctors told that her daughter had allegedly died around 9 pm. Jaya alleged that there were injuries on Abitha's body," sources added.

Abitha's parents and her relatives refused to take her body and asked the police to conduct a postmortem examination.

Ex-DMK minister acquitted in assets case

Kanniyakumari: The Principal District and Sessions Court in Nagercoil acquitted former DMK minister N Suresh Rajan in a disproportionate assets case on Friday. Senior DMK leader N Suresh Rajan served as a minister during the DMK regime from 1996 to 2001. Sources said Kanniyakumari DVAC (Directorate of Vigilance and Anti Corruption) had filed a case against him in 2002, on the charges of amassing properties worth ₹17 lakh, disproportionate to his known sources of income, during his term as minister. His father and mother, who later passed away, were also included in the case. The case trial was conducted at Nagercoil Principal District and Sessions Court. A Special Public Prosecutor appeared for the DVAC. Principal District and Sessions Judge B Karthikeyan acquitted the former minister on Friday. ENS
