Theatres want 4-week gap before OTT release

WITH theatres open again post the Covid second wave films slated for theatre release, are expected by theatre owners to stick to the previously followed four-week window before they can make their OTT premiere.

The Tamil Nadu Theatres and Multiplexes Owners Association reiterated the same to the team of upcoming Kanga Ranaut-starrer Thalaivi, when permission was requested for an early premiere. The association's president Tirupur M Subramaniam confirmed this to us when he said, "We have conveyed this stipulation to the team of Thalaivi, and this will apply for all films."

Notably, when Vijay's Master had an OTT premiere on January 29, just 16 days after its theatre release, controver-



sy erupted as theatre owners and distributors claimed that they were blindsided.

The issue also extended to the Telugu states, when Ravi Teja's Krack, released on January 9, got a digital premiere, on January 29. Later, this date was pushed to February 5.

Boat capsizes, four dead

12 fishermen rescued as boat overturns off Azheekal coast in Kollam

FOUR fishermen were killed after a fishing boat capsized off Azheekal coast on Thursday. Twelve other fishermen on board were rescued by others who were at the spot.

The deceased are Kayamkulam natives Sudevan, 51, and Sunil Dutt, 24, and Oachira natives Sreekumar, 45, and Thankappan, 60. There were 16 fishermen on board the boat 'Omaram' which left from Valiya Azheekal in Alappuzha for fishing around 5.30 am. The coastal police said the incident took place at Azheekal, nearly 2km away from Azheekal beach here around 10am. Strong tidal waves reportedly caused the boat to capsize. Since several fishermen were

at the spot, majority onboard, owned by Aravindan from Valiya Azheekal, were rescued. Seven of the 12 rescued fishermen were shifted to Karungappally hospital and one to Vandanam Medical College in Alappuzha. "Despite repeated instruc-

tions, fishermen are not taking precautions when fishing. None of them carry lifebuoys and jackets," said coastal police. The fishermen alleged that though coastal police were informed, they had not reached the spot for rescue operations.

Excise officials planted ganja to frame aviation officers, says report

THE Kakkanad MDMA seizure case — in which a few excise officials played to the tune of the drug mafia to help the accused go scot-free — is but a sample of the unholy activities taking place in the state excise department, which is yet to atone for the crime of ruining the lives of three young aviation engineers after trapping them in a drug case.

The affected aviation officers, of the Cochin International Airport Limited (CIAL), are still in a legal fight to bring out the truth in the incident after an internal inquiry report of

the excise department found that they were trapped by a few excise officials by 'planting ganja at their guest house. Though the department has taken action against the excise officials, no criminal case has been registered against them for having foisted cases against three aviation officers.

The report of the Additional Excise Commissioner (Enforcement), a copy of which is in the possession of TNIE, revealed that the case was fabricated and false.

"The ganja was planted in this case," stated the report. The report also suggested disciplinary action against the

excise officers concerned — Sujith P S, V M Haris, C G Shabu, Jose Raiby, Sidharth S, A V Pradeepkumar, and C T Sunish Kumar.

"The entire excise party together misused their official power," the report said.

The report was submitted before the Kerala High Court on a petition filed by three Assistant Aviation Officers -- Reshwanth Reddy, Jagadhesan S and Barath — seeking to quash the criminal case against them. The High Court on August 4 quashed the criminal case. Justice K Haripal is considering the case and is currently pending.

BASAVARAJ BOMMAI BJP FACE FOR 2023 ELECTIONS

IN a huge endorsement for Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai, Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday declared that the party will fight the 2023 Assembly election under the former's leadership. He also expressed confidence that the BJP will return to power with a clear mandate.

Shah, who was in Davanagere to inaugurate the Police Public School, Gandhi Bhavan, police quarters and also the central library of GM Educational Institutions, said Bommai's acumen in administration and experience as a politician will strengthen the party's position in the state. "The small but significant steps that Bommai took, like

shedding VVIP culture, stopping the guard of honour, bringing transparency in administration, gifting of books, have made him a people-friendly CM and changed the image of the BJP in Karnataka," Shah noted.

Heaping praise on former CM BS Yediyurappa, Shah said that he took Karnataka on a

fast pace of development, which the incumbent CM, Basavaraj Bommai, has taken forward. This clearly demonstrates the BJP's pro-development agenda, he added. Yediyurappa himself decided to make way for a younger person to lead Karnataka and the BJP leadership decided to give the responsibility to Bommai, Shah said.

He also said that he will hold discussions on internal security and other issues with the CM on a later visit. The BJP will grow in the future and will be a big force to reckon with in Karnataka, he stressed.

Referring to a possible third wave, he noted in some districts, groups were hesitant to get vaccinated and said it is everyone's responsibility to get the vaccine.

Cops lock kid in car to get back at parents?

THE police department that has been in the news for all wrong reasons such as human rights violations and misbehaviour with citizens has once again come under the scanner. This time, it's for allegedly locking the doors of a car with a three-year-old child inside after the parents objected to them being fined for speeding.

The incident allegedly occurred on February 23 near Balamrapuram. The parents, Shibu Kumar and Anjana, were travelling with their daughter in their car when they were intercepted by the cops for driving beyond permissible speed. The family was travelling from Dhanuvachapuram to Thiruvananthapuram when they were told to pull over near Balamrapuram.

Shibu said the cops told him to pay a fine of ₹1,500 to which he initially objected.

Shibu later paid the fine and when he noticed that the cops were not blocking other vehicles that were speeding, he questioned them for not meeting out the same treatment to them.

Enraged over being questioned, the cops tried to manhandle Shibu. Seeing this, Anjana got out of the car and shot the video of the police misconduct. At this moment, one of the cops rushed to the car, removed the key and locked it from outside even as the kid was sitting inside. Shibu alleged that his daughter began crying as she was locked alone inside the car.

Special Branch officers on Thursday evening met the couple and recorded their statements.

Karnataka releases water from KRS to TN

FOLLOWING the Cauvery Authority's direction to release 27 tmc ft of water to Tamil Nadu, the State government has quietly released water from both KRS and Kabini reservoirs to the neighbouring state.

The irrigation department has discharged more than 12,000 cusecs of water into the Cauvery river and ensured that

more than 12 tmc ft of water flowed to Tamil Nadu. This has worried the farming community in Cauvery achukat as the department has released water when the reservoir is short of more than four ft to the brim with max storage level.

The KRS level that was 120.60 ft on August 24 slipped to 116 ft on September 2 and the irrigation department released 6,103 cusecs of water into the river and released 4,609 cusecs into irrigation.
