Man injured by Arikomban dies, Stalin gives ₹5L relief

A 65-year-old man who was undergoing treatment at Theni Medical College Hospital after being attacked on Saturday by rogue tusker Arikomban in Cumbum died early on Tuesday. S Palraj, a Cumbum resident, suffered head injuries and internal bleeding after he was pushed down from his motorcycle by the pachyderm on a road in the locality on Saturday. The elephant, notorious for its love for rice and ration shop raids in neighbouring Kerala, had strayed into the border town of Cumbum on Saturday, after it was translocated to the Periyar Tiger Reserve last month.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister MK Stalin on Tuesday an-

nounced a solatium of Rs.5 lakh to the victim's family and said a special team led by Sri Villiputhur-Megamalai Tiger Reserve field director has been formed to capture the tusker. Minister for rural development I Periyasamy and Collector RV Shajeevam met Palraj's family and handed over the relief amount. Listing out the steps taken by the state government to capture the tusker, the CM, in a press release, said veterinary doctors have been kept ready to tranquillise the tusker. Sixteen forest rangers from Theni, Mudumalai and Anamalai Tiger Reserve, experienced in tracking elephants, are closely moni-



toring the tusker's movements. A special control room has been set up at the Cumbum for monitoring its movement through GPS. Over 200 forest department personnel are deployed to capture Arikomban, the release said.

Forest department sources said Arikomban was seen roaming in forest and hilly areas near Shanmuganath Dam, which is located in Uthamapalayam revenue area, on Monday and Tuesday. Veterinarians will be able to tranquillise the tusker only if it ventures out of the forest area, sources said. Three kumkis -- Suyambu, Udhayan and Arisiraja alias Muthu ---

kept on standby in Cumbum, will be brought to the dam area after the vet team tranquillizes the elephant. Safety measures including barricades have been done to prevent people from entering the area, sources said.

Speaking to TNIE, Saraswathi, a resident, said their routine life is in trouble because of Arikomban. Farmers are hit as they have been asked not to enter their fields since Saturday, she said.

Sopriya Sahu, Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Department of Environment, Climate Change and Forests, in a press release said the Kerala forest department had translocated Arikomban to Periyar Tiger Reserve located on Kerala and Tamil Nadu border on April 29 after the Kerala

High Court ordered the capture and relocation of the 35-year-old tusker. "The elephant is being tracked with the help of a radio collar. Field director of Sri Villiputhur-Megamalai Tiger Reserve has formed four core teams to operate on two shifts to monitor the elephant's movement. Separate teams for logistics, kumki handling, resource mobilisation and other requirements have been formed to operate round the clock. An exclusive TNEB team is monitoring the safe passage of the elephant to prevent electrocution. Section 144 is in force in Cumbum municipality area. Theni collector is closely monitoring the situation. All efforts are being taken to ensure the safety of the residents and the animal," she said.

Edu loan can't be rejected over low Cibil score: KL HC

'A humanitarian approach is necessary while considering an education loan application'

THE Kerala High Court on Tuesday observed that a bank should not reject the education loan application of a student simply because their CIBIL score is low.

The court issued the order on a petition filed by Noel Paul Fredy of Aluva, who is a final-year student pursuing BTech Computer Science and Engineering on the Bhopal campus of Vellore Institute of Technology. The court also directed to disburse a loan of ₹4,07,200 to the petitioner's college.

"A humanitarian approach is necessary from the part of banks while considering an education loan application. Students are the nation-builders of tomorrow. Simply because, the CIBIL score is low for a student, who is an applicant for an education loan, the bank should not have rejected the application," said Justice P V Kunhikrishnan.

The petitioner had applied for an education loan at State Bank of India, Malikampeedika Branch, Aluva, in August

2022. The annual fee of ₹4,02,000 was paid by the parents. However, it became impossible for the petitioner to pay the fee for the 4th year.

It was under this circumstance, the petitioner approached the bank seeking a loan to pay the last semester's fee. But, it was not sanctioned even after repeated requests by the petitioner.

A meritorious student, Noel has secured a job with Global Money Exchange, Oman, and is awaiting his Visa. The Visa process could be completed only if he submits certificates showing the completion of studies. For the university to release the certificates, he has to pay an annual tuition fee of ₹4,07,200 for 2022-23 academic year, the plea stated.

Noel was informed that the delay in sanctioning loan was due to a CIBIL score less than what has been prescribed for sanctioning educational loans.

The court said: "Banks may be hyper-technical, but a court of law cannot ignore ground realities."
