

Kerala HC collegium differs on judges, forwards 2 lists to Centre, apex court

Collegium fails to arrive at consensus after disagreement between members over 2 names

FOR the first time, the collegium of the Kerala High Court has failed to arrive at a consensus on the list of judicial officers to be elevated as HC judges. The collegium, which met after two separate lists to the Supreme Court Collegium and the Union government as one of its members disagreed with two names recommended by the other two members. The collegium consisted of Chief Justice S Manikumar, Justice S V Bhatti and

Justice K Vinod Chandran. In each list, names of seven officers have been recommended. But only five sessions judges found a place in both lists. The collegium convened its meeting in view of Chief Justice S Manikumar's retirement next month and appointment of Vinod Chandran as the Chief Justice of the Patna High Court. Justice K Vinod Chandran disagreed with two names included in the list signed by

Chief Justice S Manikumar and Justice S V Bhatti. The names of P Krishna Kumar (Registrar General, High Court), M B Snehalatha (Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kollam), Johnson John (Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kalpetta), G Girish (Principal District and Sessions Judge, Thalassery), and C Pratheep Kumar (Additional District Sessions Judge, Ernakulam) found a place in both the lists. The other names in

the list signed by Chief Justice S Manikumar and Justice S V Bhatti include P J Vincent (Officer on Special Duty, High Court), and C Krishnakumar (Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kasaragod). At the same time, the list sent by Justice Vinod Chandran has the names of K V Jayakumar (Registrar, Vigilance, High Court) and P Saithalavi (Muvattupuzha Vigilance Judge). The collegium did not recommend names of lawyers from the Bar to be elevated as judges of the High Court.



Kovai police 'Smart Kavalar' app to tag sandalwood trees

IN order to prevent sandalwood smuggling, Coimbatore City police has started to tag the locations of sandalwood trees in the Smart Kavalar Application. Personnel of the respective police limit, who go for night-beat patrolling will update the status of the tree daily. The Tamil Nadu State Crime Records Bureau introduced an electronic beat system for police personnel using the 'Smart Kavalar App' across the State in November 2022. This app will

record and track details of beats and other field policing and enables the officers to monitor real-time the work of the constables in the allotted beat or area. Usually, locations like frequent crime spots, Tasmac shops, residences of lookout suspects, residences of home-alone senior citizens, and locked houses of the respective police limits are tagged in the Smart Kavalar application. The police personnel who go for beat patrol will check these tagged locations and update the mobile application.

Vaikom satyagraha was precursor to all temple entry struggle, says Stalin

"A souvenir containing special articles on Vaikom struggle will also be released," the CM said. "Periyar does not just belong to Tamil Nadu. He transcends the barriers of language and countries and he had proved that by his actions. Self-respect, rationalism, equality, and social justice are global

ideologies. So, Periyar's ideologies remain the basis for past struggles, present efforts, and future development. This Dravidian model government will continue to march on the path of self-respect," the CM said. Giving a detailed account of the Vaikom Satyagraha, Stalin said it began on March 30, 1924, and it was the precursor for all the struggles organised to en-

sure temple entry of people from oppressed classes. The struggle was launched by TK Mahadevan against a ban that prohibited people from walking on streets around the Mahadeva temple in Vaikom. Within a few days, all Congress leaders in the locality were arrested and

Periyar, the then president of the TNCC, reached there and led that struggle for 67 days. Periyar spoke about the issue among people and he was arrested twice during the struggle. He underwent one-month imprisonment in Aruvikuttu village at the police station. Later, he underwent

four months of rigorous imprisonment in Thiruvananthapuram prison. While others were treated as political prisoners, Periyar was treated like an ordinary prisoner. Stalin also said Mahatma Gandhi who held talks with the then rulers took Periyar along with him. BR Ambedkar, who launched the Mahar struggle in 1929, said the Vaikom Saty-

raha had inspired him, Stalin said, and added that the struggle lasted for one and half years and ended on November 23, 1925. Later, a victory ceremony was held on November 29, 1925, chaired by Periyar. Tamil scholar Thiru. Vi Kalyanasundaran described Periyar as Vaikom Veerar and late leader Rajaji hailed Periyar for his role in the struggle.

"CLOSING down the college is an attempt to weaken our protest. But we will not leave the campus until we get justice," said a student. Some students were upset as it will be difficult for them to leave the campus on such a short notice. "I had booked ticket for my hometown on April 12 after completion of my exams but now the college administration is asking us to leave the campus within two days. How is that possible? I cannot book a new train ticket to Kerala within two days," said another student. Students have been holding protest on the campus since morning and even boycotted their exams on Thursday. When the students saw the accused teacher present in the morning assembly, they walked out following which he left the place. The students then again gathered under a banyan tree, the usual morning prayer spot on the campus, and staged a silent protest demanding immediate suspension of the accused. Later, the stu-

dents held a protest march till the main gate of the institute shouting slogans "we want justice" and later interacted with reporters. The students demanded action against four dance teachers -- an assistant professor and three other senior repertory dancers. "These sexual harassment allegations started coming out in December last year but till now the college administration has not taken any action and is busy denying the allegations. We will not tolerate this anymore," said another student. Many former students and teachers of the institute also supported the protest. The students' protest came a day after chairperson of National Commission for Women Rekha Sharma visited the campus on Wednesday to inquire about the sexual harassment allegations. Students alleged that they were not given a chance to air their grievances to the NCW chief. Despite repeated attempts, the institute's director, Revathi Ramachandran, could not be reached for comments on the issue.

He was rushed to the Tirupattur Government Hospital, but was declared dead, marking second such death in the district two months back.
