As thousands mourn the loss of rifleman D Lakshmanan (24), who was recently killed in Jammu and Kashmir, his mortal remains were laid to rest at his hometown T Pudupatti village in Madurai district on Saturday.

Later, Lakshmanan's body was taken on a funeral procession in an army vehicle to the burial ground (a farm owned by his family). The special rifle squad paid a traditional gun salute while people raised slogans like Bharat Mata Ki Jai and Vande Mataram, during the burial.

Speaking to TNIE, Raman, Lakshmanan's twin brother said, "Though his death is a major loss to us, we are still proud that he is a martyr for

the country. We both had tried to join the army to serve the nation, I will join the army to serve the country just like my brother. Similarly, he has inspired many youngsters in our village to serve the nation." Raman added, Lakshmanan had loved to play cricket when he came to the village during his leave and recalled the times his twin brother spent playing cricket tournaments along with his village friends.

Sri Lankan refugee seeking Indian passport gets HC relief

FORK Nalini, living in the Kotapattu Rehabilitation Camp for Sri Lankan refugees in Tiruchy, getting an Indian Passport is nothing short of a dream come true. The Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court on Friday helped her realise her dream by allowing a petition filed by Nalini seeking issuance of a passport to her.

Justice GR Swaminathan, who passed the order, observed that as per Section 3 of the Citizenship Act, 1955, every person born in India between January 26, 1950 and July 1, 1987 is an Indian citizen.

"Since Nalini was born to Sri Lankan refugees in Mandapam camp in 1986, she is an Indian citizen as per the Act. Therefore, she is entitled for the passport," the judge said and directed the authorities concerned to issue a passport to her.

Speaking to TNIE, Nailini said she had been longing for

this day since childhood. "I have been living in refugee camps all my life. There is a stigma attached to our fate, which inhibits our progress. I wished my children wouldn't share the same fate. I wanted something better for them. I didn't want them to feel confined like me," said the mother of two boys - Naveen and Haswin - studying in Classes 4 and 2 respectively. Her husband, who is also a refugee, is an auto driver. Driven by this yearning for a better life for her children, Nalini searched for a solution and learnt about Section 3 of the Citizenship Act and how it

would apply to people like her. Armed with her birth certificate, educational certificate and other documents to prove her nationality, Nalini approached the Regional Passport Office in Tiruchy on April 8, 2021. But the application was rejected, she said.

"Even though my parents had come from Sri Lanka, I was born on Indian soil. Not issuing me an Indian passport is a serious issue as it deprives me of my national identity and liberty," Nalini said, and thanked the court for coming to her rescue. "This order has given me a glimmer of hope," she added.

Stating that her great-grandfather was a freedom fighter and a recipient of the freedom fighter pension, she recalled how her ancestors later migrated to Sri Lanka for work and returned to India just before the civil war. "Like us, many families in the camp are of Indian origin, but are struggling to prove our nationality," Nalini said.

SL family arrives in Rameswaram

Rameswaram: Fleeing the economic crisis in the island nation, a Sri Lankan Tamil family of four arrived at Rameswaram seeking refuge on Saturday. Sources said the marine police identified them as Jayamalini (50), her sons Pathurjan (26) and Hamshihan (22) and her daughter Padhushika (19) hailing from Trincomalee.

Illegal oocyte sale: Hosp sealed

Salem: The district health department on Saturday sealed a private hospital in Salem which was allegedly involved in the illegal oocyte sale. It was decided to seal the hospital on July 15. However, around six patients were admitted to that hospital then. allotted two weeks to the management to either shift or discharge the patients.

Couple turns robbers to fund marriage, arrested

A 23-year-old youth and his girlfriend, were caught by the public, while allegedly trying to rob an old man in Bommanampalayam near Vadavalli in Coimbatore on Friday evening. The duo approached the elderly man, who was alone at home, asking for water and allegedly assaulted him, gagged him with duct tape and tied him up with a rope.

Earlier on August 4, the duo, using the same modus operandi, robbed ₹28,000 cash and a mobile phone from another elderly man near Mullai Nagar in the city, who was staying alone, said police.

The accused, identified as A Dinesh Kumar (23) of Vathirairuppu (Watrap) near Srivilliputhur in Virudhunagar and D Senbagavalli alias Priya (24), Maruthi Nagar near Singanailur in Coimbatore, are both engineering graduates and they met through Instagram.

The victim, R Periyarayan (76), resides with his wife Rajammal at Mariyammann Kovil Street in Bommanampalayam village.

Around 3 pm, the suspects went to Rayappan's house and asked him for water, after confirming that he was alone. They followed

him inside the house, assaulted him and tied him and gagged him with tape. Then they took ₹1,500 cash and 18 grams of gold and were about to flee from the house, when the elderly man's son, Babu, returned. He raised an alarm, and with the help of the neighbours, caught them and informed the police.

Vadavalli police seized the valuables, and remanded them in prison on Saturday. They told the police that it was their second robbery.

Woman Irular panchayat prez to hoist tricolour for first time

A woman tribal panchayat president in Vellakuttai will hoist the national flag at her panchayat office for the first time.

Saraswati Vijayan (36), an Irula tribal, who is the panchayat president of Vellakuttai in Uthangarai block, hasn't hoisted the tricolour since she assumed the office in January 2020. Earlier, she hoisted the national flag at Panchayat Union Middle School at Vellakuttai panchayat on January 26, 2020.

When TNIE asked about it to Assistant Director of Panchayat (in-charge) V Santhanam on Tuesday evening, he told that he was unaware of it and would look into the issue immediately. Vellakuttai panchayat secretary Selvamani said on Thursday, "None of the officials spoke about the issue and there is no

discrimination. Even I told the panchayat president to erect a flagpole on a patta land near the panchayat office, as we do not have space in the office."

When TNIE asked about this to Krishnagiri Collector Dr V Jaya Chandra Bhanu Reddy, he said that he would take steps to solve the issue. Uthangarai Block Development Officer K Sivakumar said, "Vellakuttai panchayat secretary and BDO went to the spot on Thursday and erected a flagpole on Thursday afternoon."

Vijayan was unaware of the installation of flagpole until Friday morning when she met BDO Sivakumar who informed her that a flagpole was erected.

There are 333 panchayats in the Krishnagiri district, having 161 women and 172 men panchayat presidents, among whom, 26 are from the SC/ST community.

'Accused in arms haul planned to revive LTTE'

IN a major revelation in a case pertaining to the seizure of a huge quantity of narcotic drugs along with five AK-47 rifles and 9mm ammunition numbering 1,000 from Sri Lankan fishing boats, the NIA stated the accused had been involved in activities of LTTE within India and abroad.

The NIA filed the report in the Kerala High Court in response to the bail plea filed by Ramesh, a Sri Lankan native and eighth accused in the case.

According to NIA, the six accused conspired to carry out illegal activities of trafficking in drugs and also arms and ammunition with the intention of raising funds to revive and further the activities of the LTTE, both in India and Sri Lanka,
