Maharashtra: One more extortion case filed against Param Bir Singh, fourth within month

MUMBAI, AUG 21 /--/ Mumbai police have registered one more case of extortion against former city police commissioner Param Bir Singh on the basis of a complaint lodged by a builder-cum-hoteller, an official said today. This is the fourth such case against Singh, including second in Mumbai. Two other cases were filed in Thane city. All these FIRs were registered within a span of one month.

The latest FIR was filed on Friday night at Goregaon police station based on the complaint lodged by 48-year-old Bimal Agrawal, the official said. In this case, dismissed police officer Sachin Waze and four others - Sumit Singh alias Chintu, Alpesh Patel, Vinay Singh alias Babloo and Riyaz Bhati - have also been named as accused, he said. As per the complaint by Agrawal, the accused extorted collectively Rs 9 lakh from him in several tranches for not conducting raids on two bars and restaurants, which he ran in partnership, and also forced him to buy two smartphones worth around Rs 2.92 lakh for them. The incident occurred between January 2020 and March 2021, it said. Based on the complaint, the case was filed under IPC sections 384 and 385 (both pertaining to extortion) 34 (common intention) against the six accused and probe in the case is on, he said.

On July 22, Marine Drive police station in Mumbai had registered an FIR against Singh, five other police personnel, and two more persons for allegedly demanding Rs 15 crore from a builder. The next day, one more case of extortion was registered against him, some other police officers at Kopri police station in Thane. On July 30, another extortion case was filed against the senior IPS officer at Thane Nagar police station on the basis of a complaint lodged by businessman Ketan Tanna. Singh was shunted out as Mumbai police commissioner in March this year after the arrest of dismissed police officer Sachin Waze in the case of an explosives-laden vehicle found near the residence of industrialist Mukesh Ambani in Mumbai. Singh later accused the then state home minister Anil Deshmukh of corruption, leading to the latter's resignation in April. The complainant in the latest extortion case, Agrawal, had bagged a contract to provide bomb disposal suit, a total containment vehicle (TCV) and a robot for the Maharashtra police department in 2009 post 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks, police said.

In March 2012, an offence was registered against him at the Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of Mumbai police and he was also arrested by the CBI and the ED in 2017, they said. Goregaon police recorded Agrawal's statement in connection with his complaint, in

which he said that in February 2020, Sachin Waze had met him and told him that Param Bir Singh would soon become Mumbai CP. Agawal said Waze asked him to restart his hotel business, and assured to set up things as the job of 'collection' from hotels would be given to him. Agrawal then started a hotel in partnership, but it was shut due to COVID-19 since March 2020. As Param Bir Singh became Mumbai CP soon later and Waze was made in-charge of Crime Intelligence Unit (CIU), Agrawal decided to help him in collections from hotels fearing his business will be in trouble.

Waze called Agrawal at Kandivali office of crime branch on August 31, 2020, where the officer said that he had been told by 'Number-1' that he had suffered losses of Rs 6 crore per month due to COVID-19 and in order to recover the losses, he has been given the target of collecting Rs 2 crore daily. In his statement, Agrawal claimed that Waze said Param Bir Singh had told him to have a setting with all the bookies, who would be allowed to start their business from Mumbai.

Waze told Agrawal that he was facing tremendous pressure from 'Number-1' and he should help him by providing all the information related to collection from hotel, bars and bookies, otherwise he will not allow him to operate his business as well. Waze was more desperate for collections, although the hotel industry was not open yet due to COVID-19, the statement added. During the meeting, Agrawal told Waze to seek help of two persons for collection from hotels and bars, and from bookies. Accordingly, Waze called the concerned person and told him that henceforth he had to give all the collections from bookies to Param Bir Singh only, Agrawal claimed in the statement. (PTI)

Will handle all security challenges, including that of Taliban, in Kashmir: IGP

SRINAGAR, AUG 21 /--/ Inspector General of Police (IGP), Kashmir, Vijay Kumar today said security forces were alert and would handle all challenges, including that of the Taliban, in the Valley. He sought the cooperation of the people in maintaining peace in Jammu and Kashmir

Speaking as a police officer whichever terrorist comes here, it is my job to generate input and neutralise him, as well as the threat, in an operation with the Army, Kumar told reporters at the headquarters of the Army's Victor Force in Awantipora area of Pulwama district. We will handle all the challenges in a professional manner and we are totally alert, he said when asked about the threat of the Taliban in Kashmir. The IGP urged people to share information about militants, suicide bombers, or someone planning to set up IEDs, saying the society is harmed by such elements. If there is a major incident, the locals will be the first to suffer, tourists will fear coming here, so whose

Danve says Rahul is of no use to anyone, likens him to stray bull; leaves Cong fuming

MUMBAI, AUG 21 /--/ Union minister Raosaheb Danve has criticised Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, saying that he was of no use to anyone, and also likened him to a stray bull. The Congress objected to his "indecent and shocking" remarks and demanded his removal from the Union cabinet. Danve made the remarks while speaking at a public rally in Jalna district of Maharashtra as part of the Jan Ashirwad Yatra taken out by newly-inducted Minister of State for Finance Dr Bhagwat Karad.

Giving his speech in Marathi, Danve said, "Rahul Gandhi is of no use to anybody. He is like a saand' (bull) dedicated to god. He roams everywhere, but is of no use to anyone. I have been in the Lok Sabha for 20 years and have seen his work." It is a practice in rural Maharashtra and some other parts of the country to dedicate a newly-born male calf to a local deity. That bull is not used for any agriculture or transportation purposes. The Union Minister of State for Railway further said, "Even if such a bull enters a farm

economy will it impact? It is the local economy. So, I request the people to share with police or security forces any such information, he added.

Asked about attacks on political workers, Kumar said they were a soft target for militants. Political workers have been continuously targeted as they are soft targets like policemen when they visit their homes or journalists who speak the truth. It has happened before as well, he said. The IGP said while the police were providing security to maximum such persons, it is not possible to provide security to all. However, if anyone has a threat perception or lives in a vulnerable area, then he will be provided with security after assessment, Kumar said. He said the police have got a lead in the recent killing of Apni Party leader Ghulam Rasool Lone in Kulgam district. We have got leads and very soon we will either arrest them or neutralise them, in an encounter, he added. Lone was shot dead by militants in the Devsar area of Kulgam on Thursday. (PTI)

J&K BJP chief receives terror threat, says terrorists frustrated with party's growing popularity

JAMMU, AUG 21 /--/ Pakistan-based terrorists are frustrated with the BJP's growing popularity and are conspiring to derail the peace process in Jammu and Kashmir, senior party leader Ravinder Raina asserted today and said "intelligence agencies" have informed that a terror outfit has issued a threat against him.

The Jammu and Kashmir BJP president also condemned the killing of party functionaries by terrorists in the Union Territory, saying they want to create fear among the people.

The BJP also claimed that 23 of its members have been killed in the last two years in Jammu and Kashmir. In this month, terrorists killed two BJP functionaries -- Javed Ahmad Dar on August 17 in Kulgam and Ghulam Rasool Dar on August 10 in Anantnag. Dar's wife was also

killed in the attack. "I was informed by intelligence agencies about a threat statement of TRF (The Resistance Front) on social media against me I was asked to stay alert although all necessary measures have been taken to counter the threat," Raina told PTI.

TRF is an offshoot of the Pakistan-based terrorist group Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT).

The BJP leader, however, said he was least bothered by such threats which have become a routine. In April, he had received a call and a video message from a Pakistani mobile number with the caller introducing himself as a LeT commander and threatening him.

This shows the frustration in the ranks of the Pakistan-based terrorists over the growing popularity of the BJP, especially in the Valley. During my recent visit, thousands of people

welcomed me in South Kashmir and took part in our rallies which has left the terror groups frustrated, Raina said.

He said the condemnable attacks on innocent BJP members were the outcome of the frustration on the part of the terrorists who want to derail the peace process and create fear among the local population.

The BJP is not going to be cowed down by such threats and will continue to work for peace, progress and development of Jammu and Kashmir under the mission of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas', Raina said. He said the BJP is gaining ground across Jammu and Kashmir and is going to form the next government whenever the assembly elections are held. Anti-national elements are frightened and they will not be spared, the BJP's J&K chief said. (PTI)

Traders' body asks DDMA to allow malls, markets to operate till 10 pm

trade body noted. The traders' body also claimed that there was "corruption" as they are receiving complaints that some markets and shops are being allowed to operate beyond 8 pm. "In some markets, shops are being allowed to operate even after 8 pm by taking money.

The shopkeepers are intimidated. The employed people do shopping only in the evening. In such a situation, the DDMA has to understand the problems of traders and customers," it said. According to the CTI, the markets get "crowded"

and "chaotic" as soon the clock hits 8 pm, something that can be taken care of by extending the duration of its closing time. "If the shops will open till late in the evening, then there will be no crowd in the market. Everyone will be able to do their work comfortably, Corona rules will also be followed well," it added. Delhi was under a lockdown from April 19 to May 30 during the second wave of the Covid pandemic. Markets were allowed to open from June 7 under a phased reopening plan by the city government. (PTI)

Chattisgarh: Two naxals arrested by security forces in Bastar division

RAIPUR, AUG 21 /--/ Two Naxals, one of them allegedly involved in the 2012 abduction of an IAS officer from Chhattisgarh's Sukma district, were arrested in separate operations in Bastar division, police said today.

A joint team of the District Reserve Guard (DRG) and local police on Thursday apprehended Rava Ganga from Phulbagdi police station area of Sukma, while Sukham Kawasi (35) was arrested from a forest under Katekalyan police station limits in neighbouring Dantewada, an official said. Ganga, who had joined the outlawed outfit in 2011, was allegedly part of the Maoist squad that had abducted then Sukma Collector Alex Paul Menon from Manjhipara (Kerlapal) village on April 21, 2012, Sukma Superintendent of Police Sunil Sharma said. Menon was later released by the ultras. Apart from this, the arrested ultra was also involved in triggering an IED explosion, targeting security personnel who were escorting a polling team in 2013, the official said. Ganga, who was the head of DAKMS (Dandakaranya Adivasi Kisan Majdoor Sangthan - a frontal wing of Maoists), has served an LOS (local organisation squad) member and militia deputy commander in the banned outfit, he said. Kawasi was also active as the head of DAKMS in his area, and was allegedly involved in several incidents of violence, such as attacks on police teams, planting IEDs to target polling teams and torching vehicles engaged in road construction work, another official said. The arrested ultras were carrying a reward of Rs 1 lakh each on their heads, it was stated. (PTI)
